#### DIRECTOR'S REPORT

### <u>Monthly Board Meeting</u> Monday, December 6, 2021 – 9:30 a.m. Cherokee County Elections & Registration

- <u>Redistricting</u> This process has been delayed until January. Governor Kemp has not signed the 2021 Redistricting Bill and the local maps will not be approved by the legislatures until session in January.
- Poll Worker Training Location for 2022 We have secured the Canton City Hall for poll worker training in April of 2022.
- <u>Poll Worker Background Checks</u> We will start the process of submitting background checks to the Cherokee County Sheriff's Office on all current poll workers. Background checks will be a part of the poll worker hiring process.
- <u>SB202 Requirement</u>- As a part of SB202 we will be required to provide at least one voting booth or enclosure for each 250 electors. The majority of our polling locations do not have enough space or circuits to meet this requirement. In order to be compliant with this mandate we are purchasing cardboard voting booths to cover the shortage. The quote for the booths is \$5124.10.
- Location for Advance Voting The First Baptist Church of Woodstock was unable to provide us with
  the space for Advance Voting. At this time, we will remain at Rosecreek Public Library and will
  continue to search for a more adequate facility. We have contacted Victory Church on Hwy. 92 (Oak
  Grove Election Day polling location).
- Budget Goals, Objectives and Performance Measures -

Goal #1 – Increase voter confidence through voter education and transparency.

Objective – Work with local and state parties to send out information about elections. Attend more community outreach events. The director and one other staff member will be serving on the Georgia Association of Voter Registration and Elections Officials legislative committee for 2022.

*Goal #2* – Increase elections office productivity.

*Objective* – All staff members will become Georgia Election Official certified and cross training will continue. We will conduct a study to determine in an additional staff person is needed.

*Goal #3* - Work towards decreasing the cost of elections.

*Objective* – We will conduct a cost study to determine where we can decrease expenditures.
