Call to Order: Chair Glen Johnson – 12:02 PM

Members Present: Chair - Glen Johnson, Vice Chair - Julie Glade, Secretary - Larry Hand, John Wallace, Scott Little.

Others Present: Director Anne Dover and four Election Staff Members, Ann Brumbaugh - Attorney, plus Cameron Holloway, Tommy Sandifer, and a news reporter.

Hearing Concerning Residency Challenge: Mr. Cameron Holloway qualified to run as a candidate in the August 26, 2025, special election for Cherokee County Commission.

Within two weeks of the close of qualifying, a voter submitted a written challenge to the Board regarding whether Mr. Holloway was a resident of Cherokee County at least 12 months prior to the August 26, 2025, election. The basis of the challenge was records indicating that Mr. Holloway had voted in Forsyth County on October 15, 2024.

When the challenger failed to appear on June 20, 2025, at the Special Called Meeting of the Board of Elections, Member Hand made a motion to dismiss the challenger's petition. The Motion was seconded by Member Glade and the Motion passed 5-0.

The Board then voted to exercise its discretion to investigate whether Mr. Holloway met the residency requirement to run in the August 26, 2025, special election pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 21-2-6(b). Member Hand made a motion to investigate Mr. Holloway's

residency qualifications and Member Glade seconded the Motion. The Motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Holloway waived in writing his right to written notice of the Board's action and the hearing commenced.

Mr. Holloway testified under oath, submitted documents and presented arguments in support of his qualifications to remain on the ballot. Member Glade entered a Point of Information requesting that Elections Director Anne Dover confirm Mr. Holloway's voting record.

Tommy Sandifer testified under oath on behalf of Mr. Holloway.

Member Hand made a motion to go into Executive Session for discussion with the Board's attorney. Seconded by Member Glade. The Motion passed 5-0. - 1:09 PM

Member Hand made a motion to return to Regular Session. Seconded by Member Glade. The Motion passed 5-0. - 2:15 PM

Member Hand made a motion to disqualify Mr. Holloway and for the Board to prepare and promptly provide a written statement to Mr. Holloway. Seconded by Member Glade. The Motion passed 4-1.

Adjournment: Member Wallace made a motion to adjourn: Second by Member Little. Motion carries 5/0. Meeting adjourned at 3:31 PM.
